
Did you know that the first Labor Day holiday was celebrated on Tuesday, September 5, 1882 in New York City?

NYC Gives

What is NYC Gives?

NYC Gives is a charitable campaign that provides City employees with the opportunity to donate to qualified nonprofit organizations through convenient payroll deductions.



How do I enroll?

Your charitable deductions will appear on your paycheck (electronic and paper). You can also view/print your charitable deductions via the 'Deduction Inquiry' page in [Employee Self-Service \(ESS\)](#) OR <https://a127-ess.nyc.gov/psp/prdcss/?cmd=logIn&languageCd=ENG&>.

Reasons to Give...

- You can say "I gave at the office" with pride and know that you have done something to help make circumstances a little better for the people in our community and around the world.
- It's a great way to "Pay it Forward." Payroll deduction is an extended, timed-release formula for philanthropic action.
- You can make a difference. A little money each pay period goes a long way.
- Charitable giving is a morale booster! Giving back is good for you and for the charities that your donation supports.
- It's guaranteed. All of the charities are screened for accountability.
- It's easy, one-stop shopping; and is conveniently available in the workplace.
- NYC Gives is like a department store for charities. Virtually every cause is represented.



Contribution Designation Information

You may choose up to five charities to receive your contribution by indicating the charity code number and dollar amount per pay period for each charity on your pledge form.

You may also choose to designate your gift to the NYC Gives General Fund by entering charity **code 10100** on your pledge form. As a result, your contribution will be distributed equally amongst all charities participating in the NYC Gives charitable campaign.

In the event your designated charity has ceased participation in the NYC Gives charitable campaign, your contribution will be directed to the NYC Gives General Fund.
