<p>Under supervision, the selected candidate will perform duties related to the operation, maintenance, repair and inspection of facilities, equipment and lands related to the NYC aqueduct systems and its associated shafts. The selected candidate will operate motor vehicles and motor-powered equipment; maintain and clean water distribution shafts, and appurtenant properties; perform routine chart maintenance at water distribution chambers; change charts and pens; perform routine repair work to concrete paths and steps; clear shrubs, weeds, snow, and refuse from shaft areas; utilize necessary power tools and equipment such as saws, drills, gate devices and pumps; load and store material and/or equipment as required; assist skilled trade mechanics of various disciplines; operate a forklift in conjunction with general maintenance work; and take water samples and monitor water distribution meter equipment. In addition, the selected candidate will keep accurate logs of activities and prepare reports.</p>

Two years of full-time satisfactory experience as a mechanic, journeyman or helper in the electrical trades or mechanical trades; or as a technician in a chemical processing facility or chemical laboratory.
