Job Description

Under supervision, the selected candidate will be responsible for the administration of DEP's Wellhead Protection Program. The Wellhead Protection Program is managed within the Groundwater Operations Division and is a federally mandated program to address the protection of groundwater resources. The selected candidate will be responsible for assisting in the ongoing administration, maintenance and upgrade of several groundwater wellhead protection initiatives which include: defining protection areas, local and regional contaminant inventories, susceptibility analysis, groundwater protection strategies, and contingency planning.

Qualification Requirements

1. A baccalaureate degree from an accredited college including, or supplemented by, 28 semester credits in industrial hygiene, environmental health science, occupational health science, and/or safety engineering; *or*
 2. A baccalaureate degree from an accredited college including, or supplemented by, 28 semester credits in the physical or natural sciences, civil engineering, mechanical engineering, environmental engineering, chemical engineering and/or toxicology and one year of satisfactory full-time work experience in the identification, evaluation and control of health and safety hazards; *or*
 3. A baccalaureate degree from an accredited college and two years of satisfactory full-time work experience as described in "2" above; *or*
 4. A satisfactory combination of education and/or experience which is equivalent to "1", "2" or "3" above. Semester credits from an accredited college in industrial hygiene, environmental health science, occupational health science and/or safety engineering may be substituted for experience on the basis of 7 semester credits equals 6 months experience, up to a maximum of 28 semester credits. Semester credits from an accredited college in the physical or natural sciences, civil engineering, mechanical engineering, environmental engineering, chemical engineering and/or toxicology may be substituted for experience on the basis of 7 semester credits equals 3 months of experience, up to a maximum of 28 semester credits. However, all candidates must have at least a baccalaureate degree from an accredited college.
- License Requirement - A Motor Vehicle Driver License valid in the State of New York. This license must be maintained for the duration of employment.

Essential Skills

The selected candidate should be proficient in using computer databases (*e.g. Microsoft Access*) and be familiar with computer modeling concepts and practices. This position may require some field monitoring activities and responsibilities. Candidate should have knowledge of chemistry, water chemistry, geology, hydrogeology, engineering, water ecology, etc.
