You can now [eFile](#) for electrical permit applications on the Department of Buildings eFiling system. Registered electricians are able to file applications on the Internet. This new feature expands upon eRenewal, which allows registered master plumbers, fire suppression piping contractors, oil burner installers, and sign hangers to file select no-change permit renewals online.
