## College Shuttle Bus Relocations

- College of Staten Island
  - St. John's University
  - Wagner College

The New York City Department of Transportation (NYCDOT) has initiated a \$175 million rehabilitation of the ramps leading into the St. George Ferry Terminal. The project will include the rehabilitation of eight ramps used by buses, taxis, pedestrians and cyclists linking Richmond Terrace to the terminal, reconstruction of the North Ramp access to parking areas, architectural and lighting improvements and painting of all structures. The first phase of construction is *scheduled to begin on or about May 10, 2010* and *continue for approximately three months*.

During the first phase of work shuttle buses operating for the College of Staten Island, St. John's University and Wagner College will be relocated from the current pick up location at bus station north on the upper level to the public parking areas at the base of the Grand Staircase:
