
Project Background

Proposed Improvements

- On-Street bicycle parking areas with space for 10 bicycle parking spaces
- Remove two car parking spaces on south side of street
- Add one concrete wheel stop
- Improve sight lines for vehicles approaching intersection of Wyckoff Avenue and Starr Street





Example: concrete wheel stop
