Program Background

- Row of bike racks installed in the street along the curb
- 45 bike corrals city wide
- 0 in CB 1
- Locations are determined through application process
- Maintenance partner keeps site clear of debris and snow, sustains plantings, and reports abandoned bicycles

82nd St & Roosevelt Ave, Queens
Installed: April 2013
Maintained by: 82nd St Partnership

Physical Guidelines

- Curbside lane never used for travel
- Minimum of 15' away from fire hydrants
- May not block crosswalks, driveways, utility covers




8th Ave & W 21st St, Manhattan

- Insufficient parking for block needs
- Bikes locked to all posts



Proposed Improvements



- Bike corral with space for 10 bicycles
- 2 large planter pots
- Flexible delineators
- Parking lane line to continue down block
- Remove .75 loading spaces on north side of street




Bike Corral with Planters Max Restaurant 181 Duane St , Manhattan Draft Site Plan v 2015.07.08


5 single-mounted bicycle racks

No standing Except Truck Unloading 7AM-7PM


