JOB DESCRIPTION:

The New York City Department of Youth and Community Development (DYCD) supports youth and community services through contracts with a broad network of Community-Based Organizations (CBOs) throughout New York City. Our central task is administering available city, state, and federal funds to a wide range of innovative, practical and quality programs that positively impact youth and communities.

SUMMER YOUTH EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM MISSION:

The Summer Youth Employment Program (SYEP) is more than a job placement program for youth - it is a valuable summer employment experience that incorporates the core elements of successful youth-development programming which includes:

- adult support; training
- guidance and skill development
- engaging activities; real world tasks and goals
- input from youth (peers), as well as reinforce decision making

The objectives of SYEP are to provide an employment experience that stresses the importance of workforce development and real-life labor expectations. The ability to provide greater awareness of the various support networks and programs available at community-based organizations (CBOs), and the opportunities for career instruction, financial literacy training and various academic and social supports.

The Department of Youth and Community Development (DYCD) is seeking Field Supervisors for the SYEP to monitor the performance of programs, indicating areas requiring corrective measures; investigate discrepancies related to enrollment program participation and pay allocations, monitor the registration of participants into the program, preparation of registration forms and the securing of all necessary registration material. The Field Supervisor's major responsibility is to *travel extensively to "monitor/conduct" work site assessments throughout all five boroughs* via public transportation using Wireless Monitoring Devices and applications.

The Field Supervisor may be responsible for providing some technical assistance to participants and parents to resolve payroll/work site/other problems and answer questions related to the program and application process.

Other responsibilities may include but are not limited to clearly communicating SYEP policies/procedures/rules and regulations/ file review/audits.

PREFERRED SKILLS:

Excellent verbal, writing, math and interpersonal skills required. Must be proficient in Microsoft Office Word/Excel2010; demonstrated work proficiency with the Internet. Knowledge of using Wireless Devices such as but not limited to Blackberry, iPad, iPhone, Track Pads, and applications applied to other hand held devices.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:
