JOB DESCRIPTION

The Disaster Recovery Engineer will support FDNY's production of a SAN environment with virtualized storage resources and services; support and oversee the migration of applications to virtual server resources and SAN supporting business functions and mission critical applications; define and implement FDNY policies involving storage, replication, continuous data protection (CDP) and data assurance needs for VMware failover/backup to provide technical support of storage (SAN) and data protection backup and recovery services and management.; good understanding of Networking with Virtual Distributed Switches, Port groups, VLANs; working knowledge of Windows and SQL Clustering Activities will also include, but not limited to, facilitating technical meetings, requirements definition, create strategies for risk mitigation and contingency planning, and maintain risk assessment matrices.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:

Professional/vendor certification(s) in local area network administration that is required for the position to be filled. In addition, all candidates must have the following:

1. A baccalaureate degree from an accredited college, and two years of satisfactory full-time (not classroom based) experience in local area network planning, design, configuration, installation, troubleshooting, integration, performance monitoring, maintenance, enhancement, and security management; or
2. A four-year high school diploma or its educational equivalent and six years of satisfactory full-time (not classroom based) information technology experience which at least 2 years must have been as described in "1" above; or
3. A master's degree in computer science or a related field from an accredited college may substitute for one year of experience. However, all candidates must have at least one year of satisfactory (not classroom based) full-time information technology experience as described in "1" above.
