





### Significant Events

- March 3rd: FDNY and the V Foundation for cancer research announce \$1 million grant to study early detection of hematological cancers that effect first responders
- March 7th: Commissioner appoints Dr. Glenn Asaeda Chief Medical Director of FDNY Office of Medical Affairs
- March 14th: FDNY and DCAS announce Department was one of the seven largest City agencies to adhere to an energy budget
- May 14th: US Court of Appeals finds district court wrong on intentional discrimination charge in FDNY hiring practices case
- May 15th: New risk-based fire inspections system from data mined from City records announced
- November 22nd: Commissioner appoints Reverend V. Simpson Turner Jr. as FDNY Chaplain
- December 1st: Metro North Train Derailment
- December 5th: Graduation of most diverse class of probationary firefighters in FDNY history
- December 30th: Online tracking of end-to-end emergency 911 response time reporting every segment of a 911 call from when the initial call is placed to the first arrival on scene
