At its Full Board meeting on May 23, 2013, Community Board #2, Manhattan (CB#2, Man.) adopted the following resolutions:

### Applications for Street Activities Permits

#### APPROVALS

**Whereas**, CB#2, Man. has determined within its ability that each sponsor is a community-based, not-for-profit organization, association, or the like, which has an indigenous relationship to the specific street, community or both, and

**Whereas**, the areas were posted, community groups notified and the applicants were present regarding the first four applications below, all of which are new, single-block events, and

**Whereas**, the remaining items – noted as FYI – Renewals below – have been held for 3 or more years, and after the areas were posted, community groups notified and the items were published on the CB2 Calendar of Meetings, no members of the community requested a public hearing be held regarding them,

- 6/29/13 **WitchsFest USA, Broadway bet E. 13<sup>th</sup> St & E. 14<sup>th</sup> St**

**Whereas**, the applicant was denied the use of Broadway by SAPO and presented the committee with 4 alternate options: either E. 12<sup>th</sup> St or E. 13<sup>th</sup> St, either between 4<sup>th</sup> Ave. & Broadway or Broadway & University Pl., and

**Whereas**, two residents of the area spoke in favor of E. 13<sup>th</sup> St btw 4<sup>th</sup> Ave & Broadway being the most appropriate for the event and the applicant and committee agreed,

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that CB#2, Man. recommends **APPROVAL** of this street fair on **E. 13<sup>th</sup> St bet. 4<sup>th</sup> Ave & Broadway**

Vote: Unanimous, with 39 Board members in favor.

- **7/14/13**      **Crosby Street Block Party, Crosby St. bet. Broome St. and Howard St.**

**Whereas**, the applicant requested the application be modified to reduce the fair to just the one block bet. Broome St. & Grand St. and it appeared the applicant had done outreach with residents and businesses on the block and there was one member of the community that expressed support and none against,

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that CB#2, Man. recommends **APPROVAL** of this street fair on **Crosby St. bet. Broome St. & Grand St.**

Vote: Unanimous, with 39 Board members in favor.

- **7/20/13**      **The Urban Lawn Party, Greenwich Village/Chelsea Chamber of Commerce, Charlton St. bet. 6<sup>th</sup> Ave. & Varick St.**

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that CB#2, Man. recommends **APPROVAL** of this street fair on **Charlton St. bet. 6<sup>th</sup> Ave. & Varick St.**

Vote: Unanimous, with 39 Board members in favor.


