- Delancey Street (between Columbia Street and Pitt Street)
- Pitt Street (between Delancey Street and East Houston Street)
- Rivington Street (between Pitt Street and Clinton Street)

August 2015 – April 2016

- Bowery (between Canal Street and East 4th Street)
- First and Second Streets (between Bowery and Second Avenue)
- Second Avenue (between East 2nd Street and East Houston Street)



Allowable Work Days/Hours: (as per NYC DOT Stipulations)

❖ 7:00AM-6:00PM: Monday-Friday

(Weekend Work as Needed)

- Bowery and auxiliary blocks between Spring Street and East 4th Street

❖ 10:00PM-6:00AM: Monday- Friday

(Weekend Work as Needed)

- Bowery between Canal Street and Spring Street

❖ TBD

- Delancey Street between Columbia Street and Pitt Street
- Pitt Street between Delancey Street and East Houston Street
- Rivington Street between Pitt Street and Clinton Street

New York City DOT Traffic Stipulations During Construction on Bowery between Canal Street & Spring Street

- Night Work 10PM-6AM
- 5ft pedestrian walkways
- Two 12ft wide Northbound lanes
- One 12ft wide Southbound lane
- No construction materials on Bowery
- 50ft X 8ft of curb lane on one-way streets for enclosed storage of materials
- On Delancey Street– Two 11ft wide Eastbound Lanes & Two 11ft wide Westbound Lanes
- At other cross streets- One 10ft wide lane on one-way streets, Two 10ft wide lanes on two way streets

New York City DOT Traffic Stipulations During Construction on Bowery between Spring Street & East 4th Street

- Day Work 7AM-6PM
- 5ft pedestrian walkways
- Will not impact Northbound and Southbound traffic at the same time.
- One 12ft wide Southbound lane
- One 12ft wide Northbound lane
- No construction materials on Bowery
- 50ft X 8ft of curb lane on one-way streets for enclosed storage of materials
- At Cross Streets– 11ft wide lanes for one-way traffic & Two 10ft wide lanes for two-way traffic

COMMUNITY IMPACTS & WHAT TO EXPECT

COMMUNITY IMPACTS

- Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times
- Intermittent street closures and/or limited access may be necessary
- Bus routes affected by the project:
 - Bowery (Canal St. – E. 4th St.) – M103
- DDC will monitor operation and work within DEP Noise Code regulations
- Sidewalk and/or loading dock access from the curb may be temporarily restricted while work is conducted (coordination will be arranged on a case by case basis)
- Parking may be temporarily restricted during construction

Water Service Interruptions:

Water service disruption planned

- Typically 8hrs (not consecutive)
- 72 hour advance notice will be provided
- Specific instruction will be provided prior to water shutoff
- If your water service is not restored within 3 hours of the indicated on the Shutoff notice, please contact the community construction Liaison (CCL) or 311 if after hours.

Special Needs:

- Individuals with special needs should contact the CCL
- DDC field staff will work specially with those individuals to minimize certain inconveniences

Rodent Control:

- A rodent survey will be performed prior to construction
- Rodent Control Stations will be installed by a professional rodent control contractor
