ALTERNATE SIDE PARKING RULES SUSPENSION CALENDAR The City suspends alternate side parking (ASP) rules on legal and religious holidays. On major legal holidays (those with a **), stopping, standing and parking are permitted except in areas where stopping, standing and parking rules are in effect seven days a week (e.g., "No Standing Anytime"). Parking meter regulations are also suspended on major legal holidays. On all other holidays, only street cleaning rules are suspended, all other regulations remain in effect. There are two (6) dates in May 2013: 5/2 (Thu.), 5/3 (Fri.), 5/9 (Thu.), 5/15 (Wed.), 5/16 (Thu.) and 5/27 (Mon.).

BROOKFIELD OFFICE PROPERTIES - CONSTRUCTION OF THEIR WEST DEVELOPMENT We understand that the current construction activity, which involves heavy rock and concrete removal, creates unwanted noise. Phase I work is being done to build a platform over the rail yard along Ninth Avenue between W. 31st and W. 33rd Streets. Unfortunately, some of this work can only be done after hours when it won't disrupt train operations by Amtrak, New Jersey Transit and the Long Island Rail Road. This work is estimated to take four months. Brookfield has been sending out weekly emails on Tuesday detailing the after-hours work schedule for the week ahead.
