Program Title – Teen ACTION Program

Description/Purpose of Program -

Seeking appropriately qualified organizations to deliver Teen ACTION programs to school students enrolled in Grades 7 through 10, at sites located in targeted neighborhoods in New York City (City). In addition, through a separate competition in the RFP, DYCD is seeking one Technical Assistance (TA) vendor to provide training on the Sexual and Reproductive Health (SRH) component of the Teen ACTION curriculum and related service projects as detailed below.

Target Population – Students in grades 7 through 10 living in designated high-need neighborhoods.

Service Levels/Performance Requirements –

Option I

Contractors would deliver the program to in school youth enrolled in grades 7 through 10 for a minimum duration of 12 weeks. The program must comprise of 150 hours including at least 50 hours devoted to service activities and at least 50 hours devoted to structured learning.

Option II

The vendor would provide TA to not for profits or schools to help them effectively deliver the SRH curriculum to youths grades 7 through 10.
