The New York City Housing Authority seeks experienced Electrician's. Selected candidates will install, repair, replace and maintain electric wiring systems and components, equipment and apparatus in or on buildings or structures in accordance with the New York City Electrical Code, pertinent plans, specifications and job orders.

SPECIAL NOTE:

This is a temporary assignment for a period not to exceed three months. Selected candidates will be required to travel throughout the five boroughs.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:

1. Five years of full-time satisfactory experience as an electrician acquired within the last fifteen years; or
2. At least three years of full-time satisfactory experience as an electrician acquired within the last fifteen years and sufficient satisfactory experience as an electrician's helper or apprentice electrician or training in the electrical field acquired in an approved trade, technical or vocational high school to make up the equivalent of the remaining experience. Six months of acceptable experience will be credited for each year of such helper experience, apprentice training or training in the electrical field.
