ELECTRICIAN'S HELPER

The New York City Housing Authority seeks experienced Electrician's Helpers. Selected candidates will assist electricians in installing, repairing, replacing and maintaining electric wiring systems, appliances, apparatus and equipment according to the provisions of the New York City Electrical Code and approved plans and specifications.

SPECIAL NOTE:

This is a temporary assignment for a period not to exceed three months. Selected candidates will be required to travel throughout the five boroughs.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:

1. Three years of full-time satisfactory experience acquired within the last 15 years as an electrician's helper or apprentice electrician; or
2. At least one and one-half years of full-time satisfactory experience as described in "1" above plus sufficient training of a relevant nature acquired in an approved trade or vocational high school to make up the equivalent of three years of acceptable experience. Six months of acceptable experience will be credited for each year of approved trade or vocational high school.
