



NYCHA EQUAL EMPLOYMENT NON-DISCRIMINATION POLICY

It is the policy of the New York City Housing Authority to provide equal employment opportunities for all qualified applicants and personnel without regard to **RACE, COLOR, RELIGION, NATIONAL ORIGIN, ALIENAGE AND CITIZENSHIP STATUS, AGE, MARITAL STATUS, PARTNERSHIP STATUS, DISABILITY, PREDISPOSING GENETIC CHARACTERISTIC, SEXUAL ORIENTATION, GENDER (SEX), MILITARY SERVICE, PRIOR RECORD OF ARREST OR CONVICTION OR STATUS AS A VICTIM OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE, VICTIM OF SEX OFFENSES OR VICTIM OF STALKING AND TO MAINTAIN AN ENVIRONMENT FREE OF UNLAWFUL HARASSMENT ON ANY OF THE ABOVE-NOTED GROUNDS, INCLUDING SEXUAL HARASSMENT AND RETALIATION.** This policy is in accordance with Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, Age Discrimination in Employment Act of 1967, Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, Fair Labor Standard Amendments of 1974, Immigration Reform and Control Act of 1986, The Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, the ADA Amendments Act of 2008, Civil Rights Act of 1991, and the New York State and City Human Rights Laws.
