PLASTERER

The New York City Housing Authority seeks experienced Plasterers. Selected candidates will prepare and direct the mixing of plastering materials; apply plastering materials to walls, ceilings, piers and columns using a hawk and trowel; tape sheet rock and repair damaged sheet rock walls; set up and work on scaffolds.

SPECIAL NOTE:

This is a temporary assignment for a period not to exceed three months. Selected candidates will be required to travel throughout the five boroughs.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:

1. Five years of full-time satisfactory experience as a Plasterer; or
2. At least three years of full-time satisfactory experience as a Plasterer, plus sufficient full-time experience as a Plasterer's apprentice, or training of a relevant nature acquired in an approved trade or vocational school, to make up the equivalent of five years of acceptable experience. Six months of acceptable experience will be credited for each year of apprentice experience or approved trade or vocational high school training.
