



## N.Y.P.D. SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM RULES

## **ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES**

- Minimum of three-year positive Department service, at time of application. Uniformed members of the service must have a minimum of 3.0 on their evaluations, and civilian members of the service have a minimum of meets standards.
- Minimum grade point average of 3.0 or higher.
- Members are permitted to receive more than one award; however, once a member exceeds \$2500 in educational benefits, that member will now be deemed ineligible for future scholarship awards.

## **SELECTION AND AWARDS CRITERIA**

- In consideration for awards, awardees must agree in writing to remain in the Department for two (2) years after final semester of being awarded the Educational Leave Scholarship or the NYU Scholarship.
- Awardees granted a paid leave of absence for the Harvard University, SUNY at Albany, Hunter College, or the Raymond Kelly scholarships, must agree in writing to remain in the Department for four (4) years after final semester of award.
- Educational Leave Scholarship awardees will be required to supply the Scholarship Unit with a transcript
  and proof of continued enrollment upon the completion of each school semester for continuation of their
  educational leave days.
- Awardees granted a paid leave of absence for the FBI National Academy, or the Naval Postgraduate School, must agree in writing to remain in the Department for three (3) years after completion of award.
- Awardees must sign a release granting Department access to academic records.
