

NOTICE OF PUBLIC SCOPING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT, pursuant to Section 5-07(b) of the Rules of Procedure for City Environmental Review (CEQR), a public scoping meeting will be held Tuesday, June 24, 2008, 6pm, at Abraham Lincoln High School, 2800 Ocean Parkway, Brooklyn, NY, by the Office of the Deputy Mayor for Economic Development, to hear comments from the public regarding the proposed scope of work for the Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS) for the Coney Island Rezoning. The rezoning area extends over an approximately 47-acre area of the Coney Island peninsula, and is generally bounded to the east by West 8th Street, to the west by West 24th Street, to the north by Mermaid Avenue, and to the south by the Riegelmann Boardwalk. The purpose of the scoping meeting is to provide the public with the opportunity to comment on the scope of analysis proposed to be included in the DEIS for the referenced project.
