

**A RESOLUTION OF THE NEW YORK CITY  
WORKFORCE INVESTMENT BOARD POLICY COMMITTEE  
GROWTH OCCUPATIONS**

WHEREAS, under the Workforce Investment Act of 1998, individual training grants (ITGs) are authorized only for training services that are directly linked to the employment opportunities that area in demand in the local area or in another area to which the individual is willing to relocate;

WHEREAS, in accordance with WIA section 134 (d)(4)(iii), the WIB previously determined that ITGs shall only be issued in Growth Occupations, which has been defined as occupations identified by SBS and The Labor Market Information Service,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Policy Committee that the attached revised list of Growth Occupations is hereby approved and all ITGs shall be issued only in the Growth Occupations included therein, except as otherwise approved by the WIB or the applicable WIB committee.
