

Quarterly Report on Homeless Deaths # 7
New York City Department of Health and Mental Hygiene
Bureau of Vital Statistics
Local Law 63 of 2005
January 1, 2007 – March 31, 2007

This report has been prepared and submitted pursuant to Local Law 63 of 2005 (LL63) amending the Administrative Code of the City of New York, in relation to requiring the New York City (NYC) Department of Health and Mental Hygiene (DOHMH) to track and report deaths of homeless persons in the City of New York. This is the seventh quarterly deliverable prepared under the law, which requires quarterly and annual reports. Data contained in this report are for the period of January 1, 2007 – March 31, 2007 and were provided by the NYC Office of the Chief Medical Examiner (OCME), the NYC Department of Homeless Services (DHS), the NYC Department of Housing Preservation and Development (HPD) and the NYC Human Resources Administration (HRA) to the DOHMH. DHS, HPD and HRA maintain records on the homeless individuals for whom they provide temporary housing in New York City. OCME, through its responsibilities investigating NYC deaths, investigates the deaths of some homeless individuals. Data from these agencies and OCME were compiled, matched against NYC death certificates and analyzed by the DOHMH's Office of Vital Statistics and is presented herein.

As defined in LL63, a "homeless person" is a person who at the time of death did not have a known street address of a residence at which he or she was known or reasonably believed to have resided. A "homeless shelter resident" is "a person who at the time of death lived in a homeless shelter..." A "homeless shelter" is "(i) a residence operated by or on behalf of the department of homeless services; (ii) an emergency residence operated by or on behalf of the department of social services/human resources administration which is available primarily for homeless persons with HIV or AIDS related illness; or (iii) a residence operated by or on behalf of the department of housing preservation and development to the extent that such residence houses clients of the department of homeless services; provided, however that such term shall not include any residence that is available primarily for battered women."

Based on definitions above, incident reports were provided by OCME, DHS and HPD. Information from corresponding NYC death certificates were used to validate agency reports and remove any duplicates among them (i.e. some DHS cases were also OCME cases). Data from HRA did not disclose any identifiable information on HRA homeless residents, per Article 27-F of the New York State Public Health Law, which prohibits disclosure of information that could reasonably identify someone as having an HIV-related illness or AIDS. As a result HRA homeless deaths cannot be combined with DHS, HPD and OCME deaths and total NYC homeless deaths cannot be ascertained.

DEATHS OF HOMELESS PERSONS AND HOMELESS SHELTER RESIDENTS

Reported Homeless Deaths

OCME, DHS and HPD reported a total of 43 homeless deaths between January 1 and March 31, 2007. On average, over the previous 6 quarters, 36 deaths have been reported per quarter. Last quarter was the lowest with 22 reported deaths. Of the total reported this quarter, 40 were investigated by OCME.

Nineteen of the 43 deaths occurred in Manhattan, 5 in the Bronx, 10 in Brooklyn, 7 in Queens, and 2 in Staten Island.

HRA reported 15 homeless deaths this quarter as compared to 13 reported in the previous quarter (Table 1). Among the 15 HRA deaths reported, 9 were in Manhattan, 2 in the Bronx, 3 in Brooklyn, 1 in Queens, and none in Staten Island.

Decedent Shelter Residency Status and Shelter Location

Among the 43 OCME, DHS and HPD-reported homeless deaths, 15 (35%) were reported to have been a resident of a shelter system at the time of death, 28 (65%) were either not sheltered or their shelter status remains unknown (Table 1). This quarter had the lowest reported proportion of sheltered homeless decedents; this proportion has varied ranging from 37% to 86% during the previous 6 quarters. Of the 15 sheltered homeless decedents identified by OCME, DHS and HPD this quarter, 5 were sheltered in Manhattan, 2 in Bronx, 7 in Brooklyn, 1 in Queens, and none in Staten Island (Table 2).

Please note that HRA reports "homeless" residents as living in Single Room Occupancies (SROs). SROs are not homeless shelters. These decedents had been provided with temporary emergency housing and according to LL63 definition, are classified as homeless sheltered residents.

Homeless Decedents Investigated by OCME

Among the 43 homeless deaths reported by OCME, DHS and HPD, most (40 or 93%) were investigated by OCME; 3 (7%) were not. Among the 15 sheltered, 12 (80%) were investigated by OCME, 3 (20%) were not. Among the 28 non-sheltered or shelter status unknown, all were investigated by OCME (Table1).

Homeless Decedent Location of Death by Borough and Community District

The location of OCME, DHS and HPD reported deaths (i.e. in shelter, in a hospital, outdoors or other), disaggregated by borough, community district and shelter residency status are shown in Table 3. HRA's homeless deaths by location of death are presented separately in Table 4 by borough only, as required by LL63.

Among the 43 OCME, DHS and HPD deaths, 7 (16%) occurred at a shelter, 17 (40%) in a hospital, 15 (35%) outdoors and 4 (9%) in an other location. The number of homeless decedents who died outdoors has ranged from 3 to 20 decedents per quarter over the previous 6 quarterly reports. Those who died in other locations ranged from 1 to 11 decedents per quarter in the same time period. Among the 15 outdoor deaths reported this quarter, 5 were in Manhattan, 2 in the Bronx, 3 in Brooklyn, 4 in Queens, and 1 in Staten Island. Four were found in the subway or train, 4 outside buildings, 3 on the street or sidewalk, 2 in parking lots, 1 under a bridge and 1 in a park or wooded area. Among the 4 other location deaths, 1 died in

Manhattan, 1 in the Bronx and 2 in Brooklyn. Two died at friend's homes, and 1 each, died in a hotel and in a store.

The distribution of location of death among the 15 sheltered homeless decedents was as follows: 7 died in the hospital, 5 died at the homeless shelter and 3 were found outdoors – 2 outside buildings and 1 on the sidewalk or street (Table 3).

The distribution of location among the 28 non-sheltered or shelter-status unknown was as follows: 10 died in a hospital, 2 in the shelter, 12 outdoors and 4 in other locations. Among the 12 non-sheltered or shelter status unknown outdoor deaths, 4 died in subways or trains, 2 outside buildings, 2 on the street or sidewalk, 2 in parking lots, 1 under a bridge and 1 in a park or wooded area. The 4 other deaths were all non-sheltered or shelter status unknown and locations are described above.

All 15 of the HRA-reported homeless persons' deaths were residents of SRO housing and as such defined as sheltered, when they died. Five were reported as dying in the hospital, 7 in an HRA emergency housing facility (shelter), and 3 in unknown locations (Table 4).

Deaths reported by OCME, DHS and HPD cannot be added to deaths reported by HRA. As stated above, death certificates for HRA-reported homeless persons' deaths may not be identified by law and may duplicate reports from OCME.

Homeless Decedents' Age and Gender by Borough and Community District

Of the 43 OCME, DHS and HPD deaths, 34 (79%) were males and 9 (21%) were females (Table 5). Two (5%) were infants, 1 male and 1 female, both less than four months old. Both are defined as sheltered residents and were investigated by OCME.

Two (5%, both female) of the 43 decedents were between the ages of 1 and 24 years, 9 (21%, 7 male and 2 female) were between the ages of 25 and 44 years, another 26 (60%, 23 male and 3 female) were between the ages of 45 and 64 years, and 4 (9%, 3 male and 1 female) were older than 65 years of age.

Of the 15 HRA homeless decedents, 13 (87%) were male and 2 (13%) were female. All were between 25 and 64 years of age. The age and gender distribution by borough can be found in Table 6.

HRA homeless sheltered deaths are reported separately and should not be added to other homeless sheltered deaths as there may be duplication. To comply with Article 27-F of the New York state Public Health Law which prohibits disclosure of any information that could reasonably identify someone having an HIV related illness or AIDS, personal identifiers on HRA homeless deaths were not provided; hence corresponding death certificates could not be reviewed to determine whether deaths were also reported by OCME
