

Quarterly Report on Homeless Deaths # 6
New York City Department of Health and Mental Hygiene
Bureau of Vital Statistics
Local Law 63 of 2005
October 1, 2006 – December 31, 2006

This report has been prepared and submitted pursuant to Local Law 63 of 2005 (LL63) amending the Administrative Code of the City of New York, in relation to requiring the New York City (NYC) Department of Health and Mental Hygiene (DOHMH) to track and report deaths of homeless persons in the City of New York. This is the sixth deliverable prepared under the law, which requires quarterly and annual reports. Data contained in this report are for period October 1, 2006 – December 31, 2006 and were provided by the NYC Office of the Chief Medical Examiner (OCME), the NYC Department of Homeless Services (DHS), the NYC Department of Housing Preservation and Development (HPD) and the NYC Human Resources Administration (HRA) to the DOHMH. DHS, HPD and HRA maintain records on the homeless individuals for whom they provide temporary housing in New York City. OCME, through its responsibilities investigating NYC deaths, investigates the deaths of some homeless individuals. Data from these agencies and OCME were compiled, matched against NYC death certificates and analyzed by the DOHMH's Office of Vital Statistics and is presented herein.

As defined in LL63, a "homeless person" is a person who at the time of death did not have a known street address of a residence at which he or she was known or reasonably believed to have resided. A "homeless shelter resident" is "a person who at the time of death lived in a homeless shelter..." A "homeless shelter" is "(i) a residence operated by or on behalf of the department of homeless services; (ii) an emergency residence operated by or on behalf of the department of social services/human resources administration which is available primarily for homeless persons with HIV or AIDS related illness; or (iii) a residence operated by or on behalf of the department of housing preservation and development to the extent that such residence houses clients of the department of homeless services; provided, however that such term shall not include any residence that is available primarily for battered women."

Based on definitions above, incident reports were provided by OCME, DHS and HPD. Information from corresponding NYC death certificates were used to validate agency reports and remove any duplicates among them (i.e. some DHS cases were also OCME cases). Data from HRA did not disclose any identifiable information on HRA homeless residents, per Article 27-F of the New York State Public Health Law, which prohibits disclosure of information that could reasonably identify someone as having an HIV-related illness or AIDS. *Therefore, corresponding death certificates for HRA-reported homeless deaths could not be identified and may duplicate reports from OCME.* As a result HRA homeless deaths cannot be combined with DHS, HPD and OCME deaths and total NYC homeless deaths cannot be ascertained.

DEATHS TO HOMELESS PERSONS AND HOMELESS SHELTER RESIDENTS
Reported Homeless Deaths

OCME, DHS and HPD reported a total of 22 homeless deaths between October 1 and December 31, 2006, a decrease from 29 deaths reported in the previous quarter (Table 1). Of the total reported, 18 were investigated by OCME.

Nine of the 22 deaths occurred in Manhattan, 6 in the Bronx, 6 in Brooklyn, 1 in Queens, and none in Staten Island.

HRA reported 13 homeless deaths this quarter as compared to 18 reported in the previous quarter (Table 1). Among the 13 HRA deaths reported, 7 were in Manhattan, 2 were in the Bronx and 3 were in Brooklyn; the borough for one HRA death was reported as unknown.

Decedent Shelter Residency Status and Shelter Location

Among the 22 OCME, DHS and HPD-reported homeless deaths, 19 (86%) reported to have been a resident of a shelter system at the time of death, 3 (14%) were not (Table 1). Of the 19 sheltered homeless decedents identified by OCME, DHS and HPD, 7 were sheltered in Manhattan, 5 in the Bronx, 6 in Brooklyn, 1 in Queens and none in Staten Island (Table 2).

Please note that HRA reports “homeless” residents as living in Single Room Occupancies (SROs). SROs are not homeless shelters. These decedents had been provided with temporary emergency housing and according to LL63 definition, are classified as homeless sheltered residents.

Homeless Decedents Investigated by OCME

Among the 22 homeless deaths reported by OCME, DHS and HPD, most (18 or 82%) were investigated by OCME; 4 (18%) were not. Among the 19 sheltered, 15 (79%) were investigated by OCME, 4 (21%) were not. Among the 3 non-sheltered, all were investigated by OCME (Table1).

Homeless Decedent Location of Death by Borough and Community District

The location of OCME, DHS and HPD reported deaths (i.e. in shelter, in a hospital, outdoors or other), disaggregated by borough, community district and shelter residency status are shown in Table 3. HRA’s homeless deaths by location of death are presented separately in Table 4 by borough only, as required by LL63.

Among the 22 OCME, DHS and HPD deaths, 6 (27%) occurred at a shelter, 12 (55%) in a hospital, 3 (14%) outdoors and 1 (4%) in an “other” location (Table 3). Among the 3 outdoor deaths, 2 were in Manhattan and 1 was in the Bronx; 1 was found in a park area, 1 on the sidewalk or street and 1 at a subway or train station. The one death that occurred in an “other” location occurred in Brooklyn and was found in a hotel room/apartment or house.

The distribution of location of death among the 19 sheltered homeless decedents was as follows: 11 died in the hospital, 6 died at the homeless shelter, 1 was found “outdoors” on the sidewalk or street and 1 died in an “other” location (Table 3).

The distribution of location among the 3 non-sheltered was as follows: 1 died in a hospital and 2 died “outdoors”: 1 was found in a park area and 1 at a subway or train station.

All 13 of the HRA-reported homeless persons’ deaths were residents of SRO housing and as such defined as sheltered, when they died. Two were reported as dying in the hospital, 8 in an HRA emergency housing facility (shelter), 2 at unknown locations and 1 at an “other” location (Table 4).

Deaths reported by OCME, DHS and HPD cannot be added to deaths reported by HRA. As stated above, death certificates for HRA-reported homeless persons’ deaths may not be identified by law and may duplicate reports from OCME.

Homeless Decedents' Age and Gender by Borough and Community District

Of the 22 OCME, DHS and HPD deaths, 15 (68%) were males and 7 (32%) were females (Table 5). Three (14%) were infants, all less than three months old. Two infants were female and 1 was male. While all are defined as sheltered residents, 1 died soon after birth of a natural cause at a hospital and thus is not being investigated by OCME. The other 2 are currently under investigation by OCME.

Three (14%, 2 male and 1 female) of the 22 decedents were between the ages of 1 and 24 years, 4 (18%, 2 male and 2 female) were between the ages of 25 and 44 years, another 11 (50%, 9 male and 2 female) were between the ages of 45 and 64 years, and 1 (4.5%, male) was older than 65 years of age.

All 13 HRA homeless decedents were male; all were between 25 and 64 years of age. The age and gender distribution by borough can be found in Table 6.

COMMENTS

As indicated in the recently issued First Annual Report on Homeless Deaths, a Memorandum of Understanding between DHS and DOHMH is now enabling sharing of personal identifiers of homeless decedents to inform DHS of possible areas of intervention. As a result of this data sharing we are now able to validate shelter status of all OCME reports according to LL63 definition of "homeless shelter resident" which includes residences of shelters run by DHS and HRA. In addition, as of February 2007, OCME Death Scene Investigators are reporting presumptively homeless persons to DHS' Agency Medical Director. DHS and DOHMH-funded outreach teams are then requested to assist in decedent identification and share background information that may be useful to the medical examiner in determining the cause, nature and manner of the death.

HRA homeless sheltered deaths are reported separately and should not be added to other homeless sheltered deaths as there may be duplication. To comply with Article 27-F of the New York state Public Health Law which prohibits disclosure of any information that could reasonably identify someone having an HIV related illness or AIDS, personal identifiers on HRA homeless deaths were not provided; hence corresponding death certificates could not be reviewed to determine whether deaths were also reported by OCME
