JOB DESCRIPTION

The Department of Correction seeks a Java Developer to design, code, test, and deploy Java applications, primarily developed as J2EE applications or as Java portlets running in IBM Websphere Portal. Candidates must have excellent Java Programming skills, strong experience with Servlets, JSP, or JSF; strong JDBC or JDO. Experience with JSR168 preferred. Experience with DB2 and Linux is desirable. Experience with Cognos is a strong plus. The developer will be part of a team reporting to senior IT management.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

Professional/vendor certification(s) in computer applications programming that is required for the position to be filled such as the following is preferred: Sun Certified Business Component Developer for Java 2 Platform, Enterprise Edition 1.3; or Sun Certified Developer for Java 2 Platform; or Sun Certified Developer for Java Web Services; or Sun Certified Enterprise Architect for J2EE (Enterprise Edition) Technology; or Sun Certified Web Component Developer for J2EE (Enterprise Edition) Platform. In addition, Cognos or IBM Certified Advances System Administrator – Websphere Application Server for V5.0; or IBM Certified Application Developer – DB2 – Universal Database V8.1 Family. In addition, all candidates must have the following:

1. A baccalaureate degree from an accredited college, and two years of satisfactory full-time (not classroom based) experience in computer applications development planning, design, configuration, installation, troubleshooting, integration, performance monitoring, maintenance, enhancement, and security management; or
2. A four-year high school diploma or its educational equivalent and six years of satisfactory full-time (not classroom based) information technology experience of which at least 2 years must have been as described in “1” above; or
3. A masters degree in computer science or a related field from an accredited college may substitute for one year of experience. However, all candidates must have at least one year of satisfactory full-time (not classroom based) information technology experience as described in “1” above.
