The committee discussed the progress of the Community Residence at 277 Darlington Avenue. John Cassese reported the residence should be completed within six months and residents are expected to move in at the beginning of 2011. The home will house ten residents and will be operated by the Office of Mental Retardation and Developmental Disabilities (OMRDD).

The committee also discussed the Staten Island Project Homefront and strategies to collect supplies for the troops.

John Cassese announced the Staten Island Drug and Alcohol Awareness Session, which is scheduled for this winter. The committee members suggested all three Community Boards come together in an Island-wide group, under the direction of the Borough President. Community Board #3 Chairman, Frank Morano, submitted this initiative to the Borough Board at the September 1, 2010 meeting. The committee anticipates support from Borough Hall and looks forward to working on a program to bring awareness to drug and alcohol abuse.
